During a good rainy season in July and August, over 10 million seedlings were planted in our projects, expecting at least 80% to survive the coming dry season. This is an enormous success in a political environment that is still not easy.

I am especially pleased about the developments in the Tigray region: the war there has been over for a few months and in July we were able to visit our project areas again for the first time in three years. A very stirring journey, on the one hand a lot of suffering and little prospect, but at the same time a lot of gratitude and hope for a new beginning and reconstruction. Many of our trees have helped people to survive, be it that they could eat the leaves (e.g., of the moringa tree) or cook and eat the beans or see, like from different acacia species. Also, during the fighting, many women fled into the forests with their children and chickens and hid there.



At the same time, we hope that the unrest in the regions of Oromia and Amhara will also be settled soon and that we can continue to plant many millions of trees in the future without restrictions.
















